
MULTILINGUAL PATIENT EDUCATION


MULTILINGUAL SEARCHING

Search functionality includes mapping to International Nonproprietary Names (INN), Brazilian Nonproprietary Names (DCB), and Japanese Accepted Names (JAN), allowing users to search for drug information in their native language – including languages with differing characters – and still receive relevant results. This includes searches typed in:

- Arabic
- Chinese
- English
- French
- Japanese
- Latin
- Portuguese
- Russian
- Spanish



Type the name of a medication in the main search box using the name and characters common to the user's region. For example, for the drug Risperidone (English), type Risperidona (Spanish) or ريسبيريدون (Arabic).



Search results return the appropriate monograph without requiring the user to first translate their search term to English or do research on the drug's North American nomenclature.
