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


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

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Getting Published at the IEEE

Step One: Select The Right Publication



Pick Your Target

- Select just one target publication; concurrent submissions are unethical
- Start by looking at the publications cited in your references
- Ask your supervisor or other colleagues experienced in publishing for recommendations
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

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Publishing Outlets: Conference or Journal?

- Conferences are for preliminary findings of ongoing research
- Journals are for fully-developed findings of completed research
- ▶ **Both** are peer-reviewed and checked for plagiarism before publication
- Open Access is only available for journals at this time

Note:

Authors are expected to present their findings in person at a conference in order to be published in the conference proceedings

Step Two: Writing The Article



Components of a Typical Article

Title

Specific, concise, descriptive

Abstract

Describe research in 250 words or less

Introduction

Novelty, goal, and motivation

Approach and Results

What you did, how you did it, and what results you obtained

Discussion and Conclusion


What your results mean and areas of further study

References

Proper attribution of previous work



IEEE Publishing & Open Access: Author Workflow



Submission – Step 1 – in IEEE *Xplore*

IEEE Open Journal of Antennas and Propagation 🗗









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The IEEE Open Journal of Antennas and Propagation covers antennas, including analysis, design, development, measurement, standards, and testing; radiation, propagation, and the interaction of electromagnetic waves with discrete and continuous media; and applications and systems pertinent to antennas, propagation, and sensing, such as applied optics, millimeter-and sub-millimeter-wave techniques, antenna signal processing and control, radio astronomy, and propagation and radiation aspects of terrestrial and space-based communication, including wireless, mobile, satellite, and telecommunications at all frequencies.

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



Submission process

- The corresponding author will complete the submission process.
- Authors submitting to fully OA "Gold" journals will be asked to accept OA terms and charges during Step 1.
- Authors submitting to hybrid journals will not be asked to select OA until after acceptance.



Submission – Step 1 – Fully OA journal








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Submission – Step 1 – Hybrid journal




Open Access question is not present at submission for hybrid publications




Submission – Steps 2 and 3

Step 2: the author will upload their manuscript files



Step 3: the author will upload their attributes, or keywords






Submission – Step 4


Step 4: author enters metadata

Corresponding author adds affiliation data for all authors.

The institution entered will be used to match the author with an institutional OA agreement with Ringgold API.



Ringgold is integrated in submission system




Authors should use their institutional email address




Submission – Step 5 & 6

Step 5: the author enters funder info (when applicable)



Step 6: the author reviews and submits




Articles can match a RLSC profile based on funder in addition to institutional affiliation



Acceptance


- If the manuscript is accepted, the author will be prompted to upload the final files and choose a copyright license.
- Hybrid journal authors will choose to publish open access or traditional (closed).





Post acceptance – upload final files in ScholarOne

Most IEEE Publications use ScholarOne for submission of final files.







Post acceptance – upload final files in Author Portal

Some IEEE Publications have migrated to the IEEE Author Portal, a new and streamlined interface for authors.

Main Landing Page (what an author sees when they login to Author Portal and have a submission awaiting Final Files).





Once they've submitted final files, the author is met with a screen that gives them a prompt to click and sign off on the Publishing Agreement.





Post acceptance – hybrid review

Open Access

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
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- Yes please make my article Open Access. I understand that there is a \$2,350 APC associated with Open Access publication. Some institutions offer assistance for open access funding. Check our institutional partners list to see if yours is one.
- No my article is a traditional submission. I understand that over-length paper charges or color harges may still apply, as outlined above.

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
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RightsLink for Scientific Communications (RLSC)



RightsLink for Scientific Communications (RLSC)

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- After acceptance, authors receive an email prompting them to pay all charges through RLSC.
 - In a touch-free workflow, RLSC will generate a funding request automatically when a manuscript matches an institutional profile (strongly recommended).
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
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
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
