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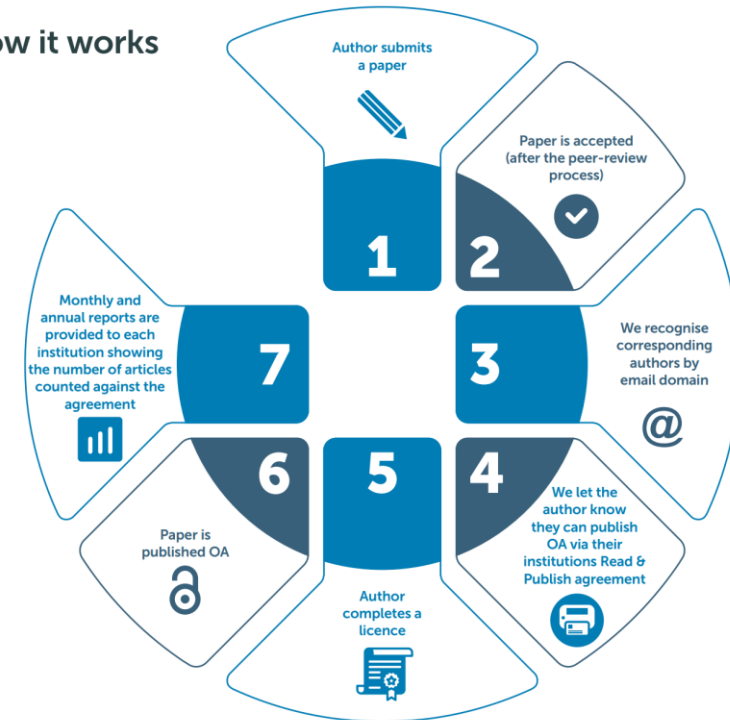
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# Workflows

- 1) On acceptance of manuscript, authors get an email with a link to the licensing system
- 2) The link takes them to a page with the details of the manuscript provided at submission
- 3) Author clicks Start now
- 4) System automatically identifies the author as being from a Read & Publish institute based on the author's email domain
