


### Search across all NEJM Group journals with one query

- Select Include Multimedia to include multimedia within your search results.






#### Automatic email AutoAlerts and electronic Tables of Contents (eTOCS)

- Receive AutoAlert saved searches via email or RSS when new articles that match as saved become available on the platform.
- Receive notification via email or RSS when tables of contents for new journal issues are available on the platform.





#### My Projects — store and manage search results, full text, and multimedia

- Add materials to My Projects by dragging them into the My Projects area in Results Tools, or by clicking the Add to My Projects button in a search result.
- Output content from MyProjects via Print, Email, Export options; Remove (delete) saved.
