Subscription to any journal includes dual access on **both Ovid and the NEJM.org platform**, which is hosted on Atypon.

What is available on both Ovid and NEJM Group sites?

The New England Journal of Medicine

- Original full-text research, review articles, and all other content from 1990
- PowerPoint slide sets and downloadable images, figures, and videos
- Article-level metrics, including Altmetrics, enhanced media coverage, and other data points that provide insight on an article's global impact

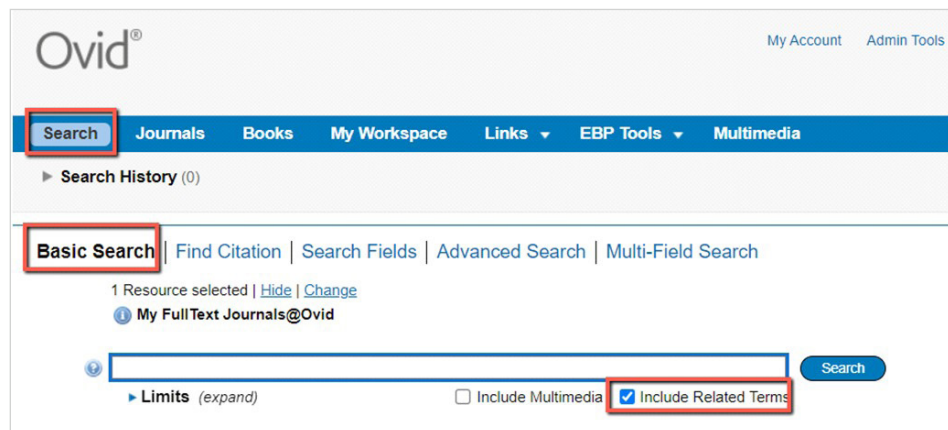

Natural-language, Basic Search (for all Ovid Journals, not just NEJM Group)

- Choose Search on the Main Navigation Bar, then select the Basic Search mode.
- Enter a complete topic or question and click Search.
- Select Include Related Terms to broaden your search.
- Select Include Multimedia to include multimedia within your search results.
