



Scattered

Over thousands of websites and libraries

Impermanent

Inactive organizations takedowns and link rot make policy reports disappear

Lacking tools

Index only, siloed, broken links, unsearchable, no version control

Insufficient metadata

Few have DOIs ORCIDs MARCs citations or other scholarly tools

Wait – I have some questions though...

Is grey literature trustworthy?

Yes... much of it is peer-reviewed

Not the same peer-review process as books or journals, but **~60% is reviewed before publication***.

An organization's reputation is on the line every time they publish, and future funding is dependent on having a good reputation.

Is it high impact?


Yes... it's highly referenced in journals and across society


