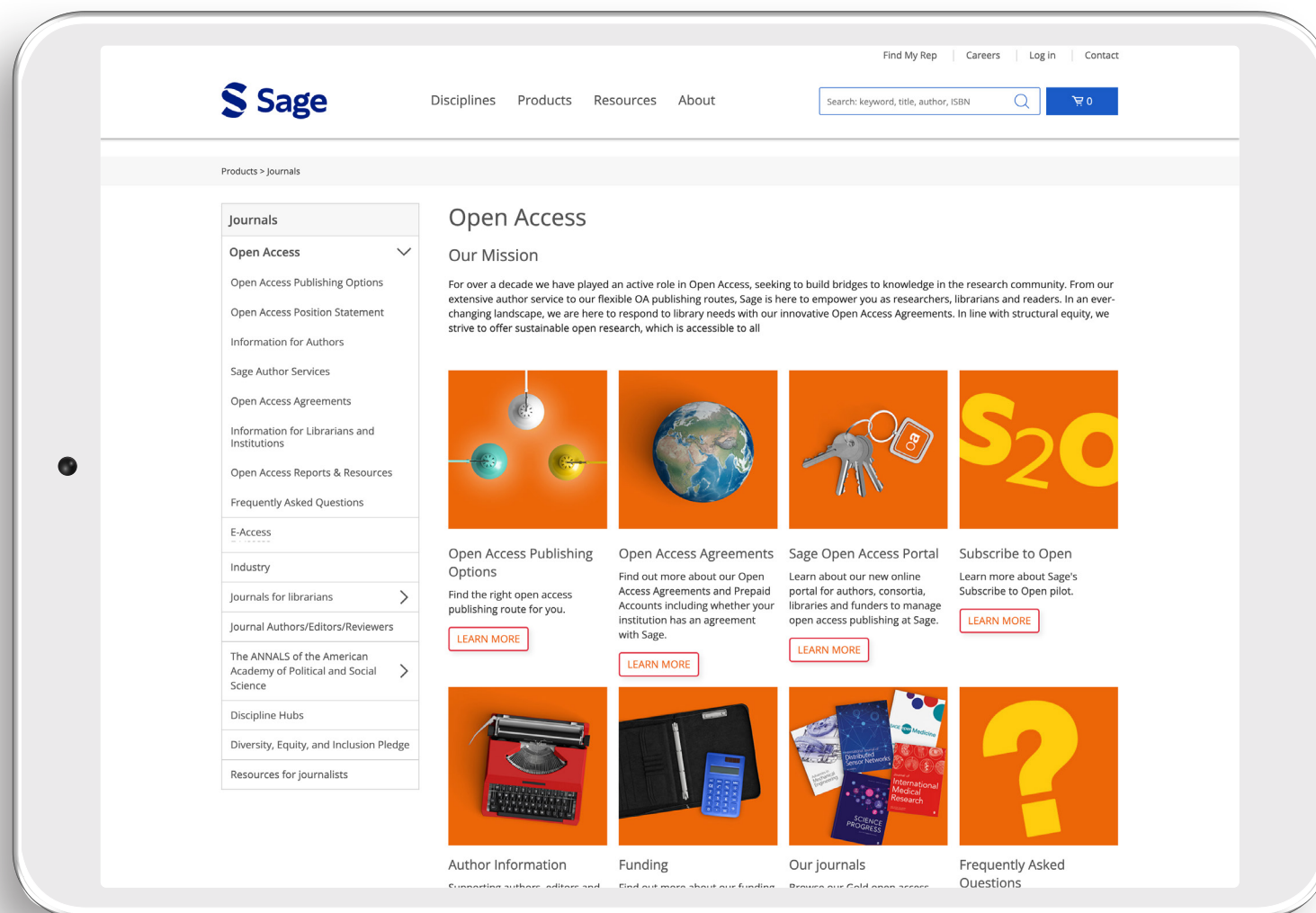

100% hybrid waiver example

If your institution is included in an Open Access agreement with Sage, you may be able to benefit from expanded open access publishing opportunities!

Benefits could include:

- Publishing open access at **no extra cost to you**
- **Free read access** to whole collections of high-quality hybrid journals
- A **discount on the prevailing article processing charge (APC)** if you wish to publish in a gold open access journal



Once your **article reaches** production, you will **receive an email** from the Sage Open Access Portal asking you to **select your publishing route**.
